
ADDITIONAL TOOLS (Not Provided)

Note: It is not recommended to use power tools during assembly.




Note: Wood dowels are intended for alignment. Additional clearance between wood dowel and pre-drilled hole is intentional for ease of assembly.


Step 1. Attach double magnet (part #6) to front rail (part E) using screws (part #7) and phillips head screwdriver. Attach handle (part #3) to drawer front panel (part J) using short bolts (part #4) and phillips head screwdriver.




Step 2. Attach drawer panels (parts K2&L2) to drawer back panel (part M2) using long screws (part #8) and phillips head screwdriver.




Step 3. Slide drawer bottom panel (part N2) into grooves of assembled unit (parts K2, L2&M2.)



Step 4. Attach drawer front panel (part J) to assembled unit (parts K2, L2 & N2) using long screws (part #8) and phillips head screwdriver.




Step 5. Attach handles (part #3) to doors (parts F & G) using short bolts (part #4) and phillips head screwdriver.







Step 6. Attach panels (parts B & C) to bottom panel (part D) using wood dowels (part #2).




Step 7. Attach long bolts (part #1) to assembled unit (parts B, C & D) using allen wrench (part #10).




Step 8. Attach top panel (part A) to assembled unit (parts B & C) using wood dowels (part #2), long bolts (part #1) and allen wrench (part #10).




Step 9. Attach font rail (part E) to assembled unit (parts B & C) using wood dowels (part #2), long screws (part #8) and phillips head screwdriver.




Step 10. Attach back panel (part I2) to assembled unit (parts A, B, C & D) using short screws (part #9) and phillips head screwdriver.



Step 11. Carefully turn unit upright. Slide assembled drawer into place. Note: Place the slidable part to the front position before sliding in.






Step 12. Attach doors (parts F & G) by placing bottom pin hinge (pre-installed in door) in the pre-drilled hole of bottom panel (part D). Then depress the top spring-loaded pin hinge so it can be placed in the pre-dilled hole of front rail (part E).


Note: Be sure top and bottom pin hinges are fully extended to secure doors in place.

Note: It is important to adjust levelers once fully assembled and upright. Extend adjustable leveler until it's firmly in contact with the floor. If relocating, adjust leveler as needed unitil it's firmly in contact with the floor in new location.



Step 13. Place shelf holders (part #5) into desired position and slide adjustable shelves (part H2) into place.

Important: Safety strap kit (part #11) must be installed to prevent tipping, damage and/or injury.

SAFETY WALL STRAP INSTALLATION

Note: It is highly recommended to install this safety strap kit to prevent tipping, damage and/or injury.

- 1. Insert short screw (C) through flat washer (E) and safety wall strap (D) and attach to top panel (part A) using phillips head screwdriver.
- 2. Drill a 11/32" hole where you want to secure the unit. The drilled hole will be at the same height as the hole in top panel (part A) where safety wall strap (D) is attached. Tap wall anchor (B) into the hole.
- 3. Insert long screw (A) through safety wall strap (D) into wall anchor (B) using phillips head screwdriver.

Note: This item is not intended for clothing storage use.
